- When complete, share your changes by signing Contributor License Agreement and then creating a "Pull Request". CA will review the contribution and merge it to the project

- Certified by MongoDB
 - Collected metrics are prescribed by the vendor
- Completely open source, <u>posted to GitHub</u>
- Built on EPA REST API
 - Shared as example code; can freely copy and mutate to other projects
