




My Defining Moment

Triple Constraint



Team Members

- Single view of work required
- Time tracking allows status to be sent and shows proof of utilization
- Reduction of meetings
- Games that we play can stop!





Resource Managers

- Single view of capacity vs. demand
- Data is provided to show need to balance the triple constraint
- Data to show resources working outside of their intent



Executives

- True on-demand reporting....beyond what you really think!
- No more top-down questions faced with rolled-up answers.
- Single version of the truth
- Metrics that are only limited by your imagination.



Project Managers

- A chance to bring value by truly allowing the process to occur.
- Real time updates allows for forward communications instead of backwards communications.
