From the EDGE Board

Change to Bylaws

The EDGE Board voted to amend the EDGE bylaws and allow CA Technologies to take a more active role in the running of this User Group, providing additional resources to help run the User Group. The executive director role will now be performed by CA Technologies, with EDGE Board continuing to serve as an advisory council to the User Group. Not much will change – EDGE will continue to have volunteers serving on a board, hold virtual/Web and Networking events by region, and perform advocacy work that includes the EDGE Users Groups' input into DARS. Activities will continue to be managed by volunteers as well as CA Technologies. Financial and tax accounting will be carried out at Smith Bucklin and CA Technologies, similar to other CA User Groups. This significantly frees EDGE up from various financial activities, costs and tax filing that we had to manage previously as an independent User Group. We believe this is the best move for the EDGE User Community, and we will work together with CA Technologies, to ensure users continue to receive the services they need to optimize their use of CA Gen.

EDGE Chair

Over the last 6 years, Larry Schmidt has been our EDGE Chair. Due to his changing role in HP, Larry Schmidt had to decide to step down from the EDGE board. His drive and enthusiasm will be greatly missed! Thank you Larry for your commitment over the last several years!

Call for Board Members

We need volunteers willing to become board members in order to keep EDGE running efficiently as a

User Group. Please consider volunteering as a board member. It doesn't take a lot of time (we have a conference call monthly) and its fun! We are currently looking to fill the EDGE Chair position. - Discussion on the exciting future of CA Gen
- Optimize your CA Gen environment with new partner offerings:
 - Eclipse plug-ins

- Web Service and SOA extensions
- Tools to reduce the time and cost of migrating to CA Gen 8.0

Feedback indicates that attendees found the meetings very informative and useful. We also received feedback that the 1-day local user group venues are easier to attend given limited travel budgets, and make it possible for more customers to participate. Due to the success and popularity of these events, we plan to expand our outreach to customers in other cities and regions throughout the end of the year, and also plan to repeat these regional customer events on an annual basis. Upcoming Events

The EDGE APAC conference will once again be held in Canberra for 2011, and is scheduled for the last week of November. A call for papers will be issued in July.

CA World 2011 registration is now open. Planning is still underway for an EDGE conference during this same time.

There are several CA Gen sessions, demos and documents available for your viewing in the Application Development Booth. This virtual event will be extended through the entire month of June so you have more time to catch all the CA Gen sessions in the Application Development booth of this virtual show.

Enhancement Requests (DARS)

Have you ever wondered what happens to your CA Gen Enhancement Requests (DARS) once CA has accepted them? EDGE performs advocacy work that includes CA Gen Users Group input/ranking of DARS. This EDGE activity provides CA Technologies with information on how the CA Gen community ranks/prioritizes the existing DARS. In the past CA Technologies proved to be receptive to the ranking since in the latest release, over 80 of the top ranked DARS were implemented. Therefore we feel this to be extremely valuable for both the user community and for CA Technologies. This DAR ranking activity typically happens every few years. It is time for EDGE to go through the ranking process again. Members who want to participate in this activity are requested to email your interest to participate in the ranking to Rob Jasper (rob.jasper@C1000.nl) and he will engage you with the voting tool (which is a CA Gen application). **THIS IS YOUR CHANCE TO VOTE FOR YOUR TOP ENHANCEMENT REQUESTS!** EDGE bylaws state that only one representing member per organization is allowed to vote. Typically each organization appoints one representative to collect input from their Gen teams, who then votes on behalf of that member organization.
