Q: Service Virtualisation sounds great for functional testing but for Performance Testing, how do you ensure and provide data to devs that the response times aren't impacted by VSE? There is a console with graphs but it plots total data and not transaction log

A: In terms of the response times, right now with Virtual Services, there are a lot of reports that we have that will provide you with the average response times (we will try and find these for you if you can tell us which version you're on). -

Q: 7.5 , 8 and 9 are deployed within the organisation at the moment. Our issue is the reports show average times and also the max time and sometimes SLA breaches align with the max times. Would love data that VSE is not causing the SLA breach
