Q: You had mentioned a pre-requisite to have a local Nexus repository. We use a standalone Nexus repository and then have DFSR configured for a backup standalone repository. Would it be possible to configure HA with a standalone Nexus repository?

A: if you have a local nexus repository, you won't be able to do a HA configuration. you have to make sure you have a standalone nexus repository for this-

Q: Suppose you start with a non HA configuration, NAC and repository on the same machine. Is it possible to move this configuration to a fully HA one? yes for NAC, according to what you told us. But

what about Repository? Is it possible to move it to 2 external machines and use an HA configuration for it?

A: Yes - you need to copy the content of the repository (of nolio, nolio-actions, and nolio-manifests). You can add all the repositories by copying content off your local repository to your standalone repository
