Back button and Recent button (New in Clarity Release 13)






In Clarity v 13, the <u>Recent</u> button lists the previous pages you have accessed during this session. You can click on the link to return to the page.

➤ The **Filter** option has changed from Collapse/Expand to the + option and is on the left side.








In Clarity v 13,

- > Refresh: Updates the favorites menu to reflect configuration changes













Interactive Gantt Chart

In previous versions of Clarity, Task / Work Breakdown Structure pages are used for reviewing the schedule.


in Clarity v 13, an Interactive Gantt replaces the Task / Work Breakdown Structure pages.








Interactive Gantt Chart



Clicking the Gantt Icon in the My Projects portlet or on the Projects List page opens the Interactive Gantt in a pop-up window.




Interactive Gantt Chart

Clicking the Clarity Gantt link in the Projects Open in Scheduler dropdown opens the Interactive Gantt in a pop-up window.






